Integration with a [learning management system \(LMS\)](#): An LMS is the backbone of virtual and hybrid teaching. Instructors can upload all of their learning materials to an LMS, where students can access it when they need to. Moreover, LMS frequently are home to discussion forums where students can share their thoughts on classroom lectures

Mobile-friendly hybrid learning platform: Today, not all students have computers. Some of them might be using tablets or even smartphones to log in to your class. Choose a hybrid learning platform that works well on mobile devices

Differentiated lessons: Hybrid teaching means that you're teaching two groups: one in class, and one that's virtual. Moreover, the virtual group might be accessing your courses asynchronously

Clear expectations about what will happen in the course and what students must do to pass: A set of clear expectations creates a structure for a course that leads to student success

Scheduled face-time with remote students: Make sure that students learning remotely feel like they're valued members of the class. Taking time to talk to virtual students one-on-one helps forge connections between them and the instructor

Optimized digital tool use: Use the chat, video conferencing, and telephony features to connect students and ensure they're participating fully in the class
